

Pioneer Banker Nomination Form



The Minnesota Bankers Association (MBA) is proud to recognize bankers who have been leaders of the industry for 50 years or more. All eligible nominees will be inducted into the MBA Pioneer Club at a luncheon during the 123rd Annual Meeting on June 19, 2012 in Alexandria, MN.

Who is eligible for induction into the Pioneer Club?

Any Minnesota banker who has attained at least 50 years of active service in 2011 is eligible. U.S. military service counts in the 50-year span if the individual was in banking prior to and subsequent to the time spent in the military. Years after retirement in which the candidate works part-time for a bank as a consultant or as a member of the Board of Directors may be counted toward the 50-year total; however, these endeavors must be the principal endeavors of the candidate.

The MBA will be contacting the inductee in May to interview him/her about their past 50 years in banking. Any background information you can send to us (see below) would be appreciated.

Pioneer banker candidates may be nominated or can nominate themselves.
